1. BACKGROUND:

Key Responsibilities:

• Preparing and managing quantitative data from research studies and complex surveys using statistical and database software such as R, STATA, Power BI, Tableau, and Excel.

- Designing and implementing statistical analysis of complex survey data, including descriptive, multivariate, and longitudinal data analysis using R and Stata.
- Participating and collaborating on all aspects related to research development and implementation, namely all phases from initiating study design and survey questionnaire development to data preparation, analysis, and dissemination of research findings.
- Where needed, managing survey fieldwork, including planning, logistics, hiring, training, supervising daily survey activities, and monitoring.
- Coding and analysing qualitative survey data on NVIVO.
- Providing support for preparing grant and project proposals.
- Helping with organizational duties when necessary.

3. QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND COMPETENCIES:

- Currently holding a Master's degree in Economics, Sociology, Social Policy, Demography, Development Studies, or a closely related field, or near completion.
- Demonstrating a robust interest in research related to social policy, social protection, poverty, education, and health.
- Exhibiting proficiency in working with STATA, R, and/or Python is required.
- Showcasing excellent analytical, oral, and written communication skills, coupled with a strong analytical aptitude.
